## Solemnity of Christ, King of the Universe



The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, formerly referred to as "Christ the King," was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man's thinking and living and organizes his life as if God did not exist. The feast is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ's royalty over individuals,

families, society, governments, and nations.

Today's Mass establishes the titles for Christ's royalty over men: 1) Christ is God, the Creator of the universe and hence wields a supreme power over all things; "All things were created by Him"; 2) Christ is our Redeemer, He purchased us by His precious Blood, and made us His property and possession; 3) Christ is Head of the Church, "holding in all things the primacy"; 4) God bestowed upon Christ the nations of the world as His special possession and dominion.

The **First Reading** is from 2 Samuel 5:1-3. Saul, the first king of Israel, was told by the prophet Samuel that the kingship would not remain in his family because he had disobeyed the laws of God. David was chosen by God to replace him and was anointed secretly by Samuel in Bethlehem.


The Gospel is Luke 23:35-43, describing the death of Jesus on the cross. All four Evangelists tell us that when Jesus was crucified on Calvary there was an inscription written on the upper arm of the cross which said that he was "King of the Jews." To the disgust of the Jewish leaders, he insisted on putting the title of the crucified criminal, "King of the Jews," over his cross. In doing this, Pilate was proclaiming to the world, that these vengeful leaders of the people had condemned the messianic King, for whom they bad been waiting for centuries, to the shameful death of the cross. He was doing even more. He was proclaiming that the innocent one who hung on that cross was the "King of Kings" the King of this world and of the next.

# <u>Updates on Family Pastoral Planning Team (FPPT) as of Nov. 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022</u>

This is just to let you know what myself, our two parish representatives together with other parishes in our West Point Family have done so far with regard to the pastoral plan that we are working on:



On Tuesday November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022, we submitted two proposals:

- One has Mass rotations in the country parishes. In this proposal, we requested that it runs for a period of two years after which the affected parishes will merge.
- The second proposal has no Mass rotation but has cut off weekend Masses in certain parishes but the churches will remain open for week day Mass, feast days, and ceremonies like weddings and funerals. We are aware that this will generate some heat!

I will not divulge any details since these are just proposals. I will share the information in full once approved by the archbishop. All we need is your prayers. But above all, let's keep on praying and promoting vocation to priesthood, as it is the only long-term solution to this.

## Updates on AAA as of Nov. 16th 2022
