SPIRITUAL INSIGHT— from Fr Weeder.

The Sunday Gospel readings last weekend and for the next several weeks are taken from John 6 in which Jesus reveals himself as the Bread of Life. It is a prefigurement or foretelling of Jesus giving Himself to us in the Eucharist. Acknowledging this, I have been talking about the power of a Holy Hour. A Holy Hour is simply spending an hour before our Lord Jesus, in the Blessed Sacrament, whether He is in the tabernacle or exposed in the Monstrance. There are so many blessings that flow from Him into us when we spend time before Him. Just as one spends time with a spouse to share love or a friend to have a conversion, so too it is with Jesus. When we are intentional about spending time before Him we grow in love, get to know more about Him, and receive what He desires for us. In some of our parishes we do have particular times scheduled for a Holy Hour when we can adore Jesus in the Monstrance. Nevertheless, you can most anytime go to a Catholic Church or Chapel and sit before the Lord who is waiting for you. One of my desires for our St Joseph Family of Parishes is that there would be someone praying in front of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament each hour of every day at whichever church or chapel works for him or her. If we do this, I know that our family will be blessed in ways we could not imagine. Many ask what to do in a Holy Hour. I recommend starting with time just to sit and do nothing but quiet oneself from the noise of everyday life. Once settled then ask the Lord what He wants to do. It might be to read His Word, pray the rosary, read a spiritual book, or just sit and receive His love. Eventually, we will have a family wide spreadsheet to identify which hours are covered and those that need filled.
