



5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send? Who will go for us?' SPIRITUAL INSIGHT— from Fr. Walter

St. Frances Cabrini says: "Have great confidence in Jesus, and may your trust in Him grow daily... Lean on your Beloved, because the soul who abandons herself in the hands of Jesus in all she does is carried in His arms." Peter fished all night long and he caught nothing, zilch, nada, zippo. That was imprinted on Peter's heart when Jesus comes a long during the day when it was not time for fishing and says "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." How can Jesus ask me to keep on fishing when I caught nothing? This goes against the professional opinion of Peter. Isn't he the expert and Jesus a mere carpenter? But there is this great miracle: they caught so many fish that the boats were almost sinking. Peter understood Jesus is indeed divine. His opinion, His ways, His ideas were so much better than Peter's; he learned a valuable lesson without Him I can do nothing but with Him I can do anything, nothing is impossible including catching men. Jesus was telling Peter even though you are a qualified fisherman and not a qualified fisher of men, together with Jesus he could catch many in need of salvation. In other words, the real Fisher of men would save all through Peter by his total dependence upon Jesus. Are we relying on Jesus to help us reach out to others or are we relying on ourselves? If we rely upon ourselves, we cannot bear much fruit. If we rely upon Jesus, we can bear fruit in overabundance for then Jesus Himself will save souls in us; we are then His body through whom He continues His mission to save as many souls as possible.
