



....“The disciples were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit.” (ACTS 13:52) The disciples heard Our Lord’s call and were able to spread the Gospel message with strength and vitality. We, too, can experience that same joy if we make room for the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts. When we use our gifts in the way that God intends, He fills us with supernatural joy. A joy that others notice and are attracted to!

SPIRITUAL INSIGHT— Fr. Walter Jong-A-Kiem

Jesus calls us to listen; the sheep hear the voice of the Good Shepherd and follow Him. They understand that He lays down His life for His sheep. Mary is the model of listening to Jesus her beloved Son. She says behold the handmaid of the Lord; may it be done to me according to Your will. Mary clings to His every word and treasures them like precious jewels. Why? She knows that God speaks His holy words from His Heart, a Heart that is on fire, a Heart that cannot stop loving, a Heart that is so tender. Some people contradicted Paul and Barnabas and expelled them from their territory. They spoke His words that were utterly rejected because these people did not see a God of Love but a God Who is so demanding and hard to please. Why is there so much resistance to the words spoken by God? Words that are full of Truth and set us free, and have power to change us into children of God, another Christ. The Power of the word of God is unleashed only when we love the good Shepherd, when we trust Him and receive His words with a humble loving and trusting heart. There is so much untapped power in the word of God, spoken by Him to us, that His words can set us free from shame, guilt, hatred, lies, deceit, sickness, death. When we believe His words spoken to us, miracles of healing, conversion, and transformation happen that astound many. The enemy instead wants us to believe his lies that we are no good, unwanted, unlovable, a burden, and lost forever. The more I believe a lie, the more it hurts me and the less I believe a lie the less it hurts me. Jesus’ sheep listen to Him and move from believing a lie to the truth more and more so that His words become en-fleshed in them to become Jesus by grace more and more by the power of the Spirit.
