NOTES FROM FR. WEEDER

If you missed the news last week, Fr Greg Carl has been named the President of GACC. Fr Carl and I were in the seminary together and he was ordained one year after me. He has been involved with schools throughout his priesthood and will bring much insight and experience to this position. While he is President of GACC, he will also continue to serve as servant minister to the priests of the Archdiocese. Hence, he is not assigned to the parish, only GACC.

A CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION will be held at St Boniface next Sunday, June 7 beginning with Mass that fulfills the Sunday obligation at 2pm. The practice of having a Corpus Christi (Body of Christ) Procession dates back to the 13th century. In 1891, St Boniface parishioners looked back to their Old World tradition for a feast through which they could thank God for the blessings they had received. The feast they chose was called "Fronleichnamfest" or Corpus Christi. This tradition at St Boniface continued every year up to about 6 years ago. Today we also are thankful for the many blessings we have received and want to honor our Lord in the same fashion. The Mass and Procession is open to everyone and I hope to see members from all parishes in our family celebrate this feast together.
